The Prayer Secret Hidden in Plain Sight

Many have read it, but few have seen it, even as Jesus taught it.

Aiteo is a style or type of authoritative prayer as Jesus taught in the Our Father (Matt 6:8), meaning to demand, command, require, and expect as due by covenant promise in focused intention, and in the New Testament, knowing Jesus met all the requirements for our access to God. Many English translations hide the authority and intensity of this word by translating it as, "ask."

As a style, the actual word is not often used explicitly; rather we infer it from the recorded words. A typical example in common use is, "God bless you, in the Name of Jesus," as a command for God's help and intervention. (NOTE: I seem to get more results when I say it with focused intention. *Aiteo* does not have to be loud, but it should be intense.)

In our article "Aiteo-Demand as Due", https://covenantpeaceministries.com/Articles.html, we found 95 passages using this style in the Psalms. In the Epistles below, we found 96 passages using *aiteo* prayer, blessings, commands, decrees, and praises.

This *aiteo* style is used in commanding healing, casting out demons, and praises to God. It is also used in all the 1,050 New Testament Commands or Rules issued by the apostles. So every Command is also an *aiteo*-type command where obedience releases *zoe* life, and the means whereby believers release, execute, manifest, receive, and/or implement the promises of God.

Almost every form of ministry Jesus used in healing, demon deliverance, controlling the weather, etc. was in the *aiteo* style. Only in the Garden, to confirm God's will, He said, in effect, "If this is what I have to do, then I will do it gladly." Then He arose as a King going to battle. - 2 (Which he had promised afore by his prophets in the Holy Scriptures,)
- 3 Concerning his Son Jesus Christ our Lord, which was made of the seed of David according to the flesh;
- 4 And declared to be the Son of God with power, according to the spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead:
- 5 By whom we have received grace and apostleship, for obedience to the faith among all nations, for his name:
- 6 Among whom are ye also the called of Jesus Christ:
- 7 To all that be in Rome, beloved of God, called to be saints: **Grace to you and peace from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ**."

2. Rom 1:8-12

EXPANDED: 16 "For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ (*Good New of God for Mankind*): for it (*the Gospel*) is the *dunamis/ miracle* power of God unto salvation (*of everything of Heaven on Earth*) to every one that believeth (*by continual right faith actions to cleave to the Lord and His Word*); to the Jew first, and also to the Greek. 17 For therein (*the Gospel/Good News for Man of God*) is the righteousness (*human duplication of Jesus in men*) of God revealed from faith (*actions-Old Testament*) to faith (*actions-New Testament*): as it is written, The just (*those made the righteousness of God in Jesus as a Jesus duplicate by the New Birth*) shall *zao/*live (*operate in zoe life-dunamis miracle power as a Jesus duplicate*) by faith (*the zoe life-releasing, right faith-action lifestyle of Jesus*)."

4. Rom 10:1-4

10 "Brethren, my heart's desire and prayer to God for Israel is, that they might be saved.
