

You already have all there is of God by Grace: We access and operate these by right faith-actions.

ACCESSED BY GRACE:

Rom 4:16 “Therefore it is of *pistis/faith (continual right faith-actions)*, that it might be by grace; to the end the promise (8,000 covenant promises, grace) might be sure to all the seed; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the *pistis/faith of (lifestyle of continual right faith-actions in seeking the Lord and His face as your very necessary life)* Abraham; who is the father of us all.”

Rom 4:13 “For the promise (grace), that he should be the heir of the world, was not to Abraham, or to his seed, through the law, but through the righteousness (*right faith-action lifestyle*) of *pistis/faith (continual right faith-actions)*.”

Rom 5:2 “By whom also we have **access (and operate) by faith (continual right faith-actions) into this grace** wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.”

2 Cor 8:7 “Therefore, as ye abound in every thing, in *pistis/faith (continual right faith-actions)*, and utterance, and knowledge, and in all diligence (*of continually seeking the Lord*), and in your love to us, see that ye **abound in this grace** (*operated and released by right faith-actions*) also.”

Gal 3:22 “But the scripture hath concluded all under sin, that the promise (*covenant promise, grace*) by *pistis/faith (of continually seeking the Lord)* of Jesus Christ might be given to them that *pisteuo/believe (lifestyle of continual right faith-actions in seeking the Lord and His face as your very necessary life)*.”

Eph 2:7 “That in the ages to come he (*Father God*) might shew the exceeding riches of **his grace** in his kindness toward us through Christ Jesus. 8 For by grace are ye *sozo/saved (eternal position and manifesting the promises, grace, in this life)* through *pistis/faith (continual right faith-actions of seeking the Lord)*; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9 not of works, lest any man should boast. 10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good *Jesus-level-duplicate* works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.”

Heb 6:11 “And we desire that every one of you do shew (*labor, work*) the same diligence to the full assurance of hope unto the end: 12 that ye be not slothful, but followers (*copycats, duplicates, disciples*) of them who through *pistis/faith (continual right faith-actions of seeking the Lord)* and patience (*consistent in continual right faith-actions of seeking the Lord*) inherit (*release, operate*) the promises (*covenant promises authorized by grace*).”

Heb 11:5 “By *pistis/faith (continual right faith-actions of seeking the Lord)* Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that **he pleased God**. 6 But without *pistis/faith (continual right faith-actions of seeking the Lord)* it is impossible to please him (*God*): for he that cometh to God must *pisteuo/believe (continual right faith-actions of seeking the Lord unto joy behaviors)* that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently (*consistent and intense labor*) seek him (*by the continual right faith-actions of seeking the Lord*).”

Heb 4:1 “Let us therefore fear, lest, a promise (*covenant promise, grace*) being left us of entering into his rest, any of you should seem to come short of it. 2 For unto us was the gospel [*of grace in Jesus*]

preached, as well as unto them: but the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with *pistis/faith (continual right faith-actions of seeking the Lord unto joy behaviors)* in them that heard it.”

GRACES ALREADY GIVEN AND DECREED for release and operation by right faith-actions.

Matt 6:33 “But seek (*by continual right faith-actions of seeking the Lord unto joy behaviors*) ye first the kingdom of God (*as Jesus demonstrated and even greater*), and his righteousness (*manifested Jesus-duplication*); and all these things shall be added unto you.”

Luke 12:31 “*Jesus said*: But rather seek faith (*by continual right faith-actions of seeking the Lord unto joy behaviors*) ye the kingdom of God (*as Jesus manifested*); and all these things shall be added unto you.”

Gal 1:3 “Grace be to you and peace from God the Father, and from our Lord Jesus Christ, 4 who gave himself for our sins, that he might deliver us from this present evil world (*system, age, order*), according to the will of God and our Father: 5 to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen.”

Philem 6 “That the communication of thy *pistis/faith* may become effectual (*in manifesting the Kingdom of God as Jesus did*) by the *continual* acknowledging of every good thing which is *already* in you in Christ Jesus *by the new birth and Holy Spirit baptism*.”

2 Peter 1:1 “Simon Peter, a servant and an apostle of Jesus Christ, to them that have obtained like precious faith with us through the righteousness of God and our Saviour Jesus Christ: 2 Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord, 3 According as his divine power **hath given unto us all things that pertain unto *zoe/life and godliness***, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue: 4 whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

5 And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your *pistis/faith* virtue; and to virtue knowledge; 6 and to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness; 7 and to godliness (*Jesus-duplication*) brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness charity. 8 For if these things be in you, and abound, they make you that ye shall neither be barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. 9 But he that lacketh these things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and hath forgotten that he was purged from his old sins. 10 Wherefore the rather, brethren, give diligence to make your calling and election sure: for if ye do these things, ye shall never fall: 11 **for so an entrance shall be ministered unto you abundantly into the everlasting kingdom of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.**”

Rom 8:31 “What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us? 32 He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him **also freely give us all things**? 33 Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifieth. 34 Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us.”

1 Cor 3:21 “Therefore let no man glory in men. For all things are yours; 22 Whether Paul, or Apollos, or Cephas, or the world, or *zoe/life*, or death, or things present, or things to come; **all are yours**; 23 and ye are Christ's; and Christ is God's.”

1 Tim 4:8 “For bodily exercise profiteth little: but godliness (*right faith-actions to Jesus-duplication*) is profitable unto all things, having promise of the *zoe/life* that now is, and of that which is to come.”

Eph 1:2 “Grace be to you, and peace, from God our Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ. 3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us **with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ**: 4 according as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in *agape/love*: 5 having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will, 6 to the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved. 7 In whom we have redemption through his (*Jesus'*) blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace; 8 wherein he hath abounded toward us in all wisdom and prudence; 9 having made known unto us the mystery of his will, according to his good pleasure which he hath purposed in himself: 10 that in the dispensation of the fulness of times he might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; even in him (*Jesus*): 11 in whom also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestinated according to the purpose of him who worketh all things after the counsel of his own will: 12 that we should be to the praise of his glory, who first trusted in Christ.”

2 Cor 1:18 “But as God is true, our word toward you was not yea and nay. 19 For the Son of God, Jesus Christ, who was preached among you by us, even by me and Silvanus and Timotheus, was not yea and nay, but in him was yea. 20 **For all the promises of God in him (*Jesus*) are yea, and in him (*Jesus*) Amen, unto the glory of God by us.** 21 Now he which stablisheth us with you in Christ, and hath anointed us, is God; 22 who hath also sealed us, and given the earnest (*guarantee*) of the Spirit in our hearts.”

Rom 6:23 “For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.”

Gal 3:22 “But the scripture hath concluded all under sin, that the promise by *pistis/faith* of Jesus Christ might be given to them that *pisteuo/believe*. 23 But before *pistis/faith* came, we were kept under the law, shut up unto the *pistis/faith* which should afterwards be revealed. 24 Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by *pistis/faith*.”

Heb 6:11 “And we desire that every one of you do shew the same diligence to the full assurance of hope unto the end: 12 that ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises.”

Heb 11:39 “And these all, having obtained a good report through *pistis/faith*, received not the promise: 40 God having provided some better thing for us, that they without us should not be made perfect.”

Heb 13:8 “Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.”

1 John 5:11 “And this is the record, that God hath given to us eternal *zoe/life*, and this *zoe/life* is in his Son. 12 He that hath the Son hath *zoe/life*; and he that hath not the Son of God hath not *zoe/life*. 13 These things have I written unto you that *pisteuo/believe* on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal *zoe/life*, and that ye may *pisteuo/believe* on the name of the Son of God. 14 And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we *aiteo/ask* **any thing according to his will**, (*covenant promises*) he heareth us: 15 and if we know that he hear us, **whatsoever** we *aiteo/ask*, we know that we have the *aiteo/petitions* that we *aiteo/desired* of him. 16 If any man see his brother sin a

sin which is not unto death, he shall *aiteo*/ask, and he shall give him *zoe*/life for them that sin not unto death. There is a sin unto death: I do not say that he shall pray for it.”

2 Cor 4:6 “For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ. 7 But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellency of the *dunamis/miracle* power may be of God, and not of us.”

2 Cor 2:14 “Now thanks be unto God, which **always causeth us to triumph in Christ**, and maketh manifest the savour of his knowledge by us in every place.”

John 14:11 “*Pisteuo*/Believe me that I am in the Father, and the Father in me: or else believe me for the very works' sake (*so you can also do them*). 12 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that *pisteuo*/believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father. 13 And whatsoever ye shall *aiteo*/ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. 14 If ye shall *aiteo*/ask **any thing in my name**, I will do it. 15 If ye *agape*/love me, keep my commandments.”

John 15:7 “If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall *aiteo*/ask **what ye will**, and it shall be done unto you. 8 Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples.”

John 16:23 “And in that day ye shall ask me nothing. Verily, verily, I say unto you, **Whatsoever** ye shall *aiteo*/ask the Father in my name, he will give it you. 24 Hitherto have ye *aiteo*/asked nothing in my name: *aiteo*/ask (*and keep on aiteo asking*), and ye shall receive, that your joy may be full.”

Mark 11:22 “And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have *pistis*/faith in God (*Margin note: do faith like God does faith*). 23 For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall *pisteuo*/believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have **whatsoever he saith**. 24 Therefore I say unto you, **What things soever** ye *aiteo*/desire, when ye pray, *pisteuo*/believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them. 25 And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses. 26 But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses.”

Matt 21:19 “And when he (*Jesus*) saw a fig tree in the way, he came to it, and found nothing thereon, but leaves only, and said unto it, Let no fruit grow on thee henceforward for ever. And presently the fig tree withered away. 20 And when the disciples saw it, they marvelled, saying, How soon is the fig tree withered away! 21 Jesus answered and said unto them, Verily I say unto you, If ye have *pistis*/faith, and doubt not, ye shall not only do this which is done to the fig tree, but also if ye shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; it shall be done. **22 And all things, whatsoever** ye shall *aiteo*/ask in prayer, *pisteuo*/believing (*by continual right faith-actions unto joy behaviors and aiteo commands*), ye shall receive.”

Matt 6:6 “But thou, when thou prayest, enter into thy closet, and when thou hast shut thy door, pray to thy Father which is in secret; and thy Father which seeth in secret shall reward thee openly. 7 But when ye pray, use not vain repetitions, as the heathen do: for they think that they shall be heard for their much speaking. 8 Be not ye therefore like unto them: for your Father knoweth what things ye have need of, before ye *aiteo*/ask him. 9 After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven,

AITEO: Hallowed be thy name. 10 AITEO: Thy kingdom come. AITEO: Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. 11 AITEO: Give us this day our daily bread. 12 AITEO: And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. 13 AITEO: And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen. 14 For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: 15 but if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.”

1 John 3:16 “Hereby perceive we the love of God, because he laid down his *psuche*/life (*soul*) for us: and we ought to lay down our *psuche*/lives (*soul*) for the brethren. 17 But whoso hath this world's good, and seeth his brother have need, and shutteth up his bowels of compassion from him, how dwelleth the *agape*/love of God in him? 18 My little children, let us not *agape*/love in word, neither in tongue; but in deed and in truth. 19 And hereby we know that we are of the truth, and shall assure our hearts before him. 20 For if our heart condemn us, God is greater than our heart, and knoweth all things. 21 *Agapao*/Beloved, if our heart condemn us not, then have we confidence toward God. 22 And **whatsoever** we *aiteo*/ask, we receive of him, because we keep his commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in his sight. 23 And this is his commandment, That we should *pisteuo*/believe on the name of his Son Jesus Christ, and *agape*/love one another, as he gave us commandment. 24 And he that keepeth his commandments dwelleth in him, and he in him. And hereby we know that he abideth in us, by the Spirit which he hath given us.”

Heb 11:5 “By *pistis*/faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God. 6 But without *pistis*/faith (*right faith-actions unto joy behaviors*) it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must *pisteuo*/believe (*right faith-actions unto joy behaviors*) that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him (*by continual right faith-actions per Ps 105:1-5; Ps 34*).”

1 Cor 1:30 “But of him (*Father God*) **are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption**: 31 that, according as it is written, He that glorieth, let him glory in the Lord.”

2 Cor 5:17 “Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature (*a new species never seen before*): old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new. 18 And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation; 19 to wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation. 20 Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God. 21 **For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.** 6:1 We then, as workers together with him, beseech you also that ye receive not the grace of God in vain. 2 (For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)”

Gal 2:19 “For I through the law am dead to the law, that I might *zao*/live unto God. 20 **I am (*have been*) crucified with Christ: nevertheless I *zao*/live; yet not I, but Christ *zao*/liveth in me: and the life which I now *zao*/live in the flesh I *zao*/live by the *pistis*/faith-actions of/in the Son of God, who *agapao*/loved**

me, and gave himself for me. 21 I do not frustrate the grace of God: for if righteousness unto zoe life come by the law, then Christ is dead in vain."

Rom 8:15 "For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father. 16 The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: 17 and if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and **joint-heirs with Christ (access to all of Jesus by right faith-actions)**; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together."

Col 1:26 "Even the mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but now is made manifest to his saints: 27 to whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is **Christ in you, the hope of glory**: 28 whom we preach, warning every man, and teaching every man in all wisdom; that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus: 29 whereunto I also labour, striving according to his working, which worketh in me mightily."

Col 2:8 "Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ. 9 **For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily**. 10 **And ye are complete in him**, which is the head of all principality and power: 11 in whom also ye are circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, in putting off the body of the sins of the flesh by the circumcision of Christ: 12 buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with him through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead. 13 And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he *zao*/quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses; 14 blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross; 15 and having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it."

1 Cor 6:19 "What? know ye not **that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you**, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? 20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's."

2 Cor 6:15 "And what concord hath Christ with Belial? or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel? 16 And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? **for ye are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people**. 17 Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you, 18 and will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty."

1 John 5:20 "And we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and **we are in him that is true, even in his Son Jesus Christ**. This is the true God, and eternal *zoe*/life."

Rom 8:9 "But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his. 10 **And if Christ be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but the Spirit is zoe/life because of righteousness**. 11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall **also zao/quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you**."

Mark 16:15 “And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. 16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. 17 And **these signs shall follow them that believe**; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 they shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover. 19 So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, he was received up into heaven, and sat on the right hand of God. 20 And they went forth, and preached everywhere, **the Lord working and confirming the word (of grace) with signs following.** Amen.”

2 Tim 1:13 “Hold fast the form of sound words, which thou hast heard of me, in faith and love which is in Christ Jesus. 14 That good thing which was committed unto thee keep by **the Holy Ghost which dwelleth in us.**”

1 John 4:15 “Whosoever shall confess that Jesus is the Son of God, **God dwelleth in him, and he in God.** 16 And we have known and believed the love that God hath to us. God is love; and he that dwelleth in love dwelleth in God, and God in him. 17 Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: **because as he is (now), so are we in this world.**”

Psalms 51:10 “Create in me a clean heart, O God; **and renew a right spirit within me.**”

Ezekiel 18:31 “Cast away from you all your transgressions, whereby ye have transgressed; and **make you a new heart and a new spirit**: for why will ye die, O house of Israel?”

Ezekiel 36:26 “A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, **and I will give you an heart of flesh.**”

Romans 13:14 “**But put ye on the Lord Jesus Christ**, and make not provision for the flesh, to fulfil the lusts thereof.”

2 Corinthians 5:17 “Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; **behold, all things are become new.**”

Ephesians 1:18 “The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and **what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints.**”

Ephesians 4:22 “That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; 23 and be renewed in the spirit of your mind; **24 and that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.**”

Colossians 1:21 “And you, that were sometime alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now hath he reconciled 22 in the body of his flesh through death, **to present you holy and unblameable and unproveable in his sight:**”

Colossians 3:10 “**And have put on the new man**, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him:”

Titus 3:5 “Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and **renewing of the Holy Ghost.**”

Rom 16:20 “And the **God of peace shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly**. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen.”

2 Tim 1:6 “Wherefore I put thee in remembrance that thou stir up the gift of God, which is in thee by the putting on of my hands. **7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.** 8 Be not thou therefore ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me his prisoner: but be thou partaker of the afflictions of the gospel according to the power of God; 9 who hath saved us, and called us with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began, 10 but is now made manifest by the appearing of our Saviour Jesus Christ, who hath abolished death, and hath brought life and immortality to light through the gospel: 11 whereunto I (*Paul*) am appointed a preacher, and an apostle, and a teacher of the Gentiles.”

1 John 3:1 “Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, **that we should be called the sons of God**: therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew him not. 2 Beloved, **now are we the sons of God**, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is. 3 And every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure.

And presently the fig tree withered away. 20 And when the disciples saw it, they marvelled, saying, How soon is the fig tree withered away! 21 Jesus answered and said unto them, Verily I say unto you, **If ye have pistis/faith**, and doubt not, ye shall not only do this which is done to the fig tree, but also if ye shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; it shall be done. 22 And all things, **whatsoever ye shall aiteo/ask in prayer, pisteuo/believing** (*n continual right faith-actions unto joy behaviors*), ye shall receive.”

Mark 11:13 “And seeing a fig tree afar off having leaves, he came, if haply he might find any thing thereon: and when he came to it, he found nothing but leaves; for the time of figs was not yet. 14 And Jesus answered and said unto it, No man eat fruit of thee hereafter for ever. And his disciples heard it. 15 And they come to Jerusalem: and Jesus went into the temple, and began to cast out them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves; 16 and would not suffer that any man should carry any vessel through the temple. 17 And he taught, saying unto them, Is it not written, My house shall be called of all nations the house of prayer?

but ye have made it a den of thieves. 18 And the scribes and chief priests heard it, and sought how they might destroy him: for they feared him, because all the people was astonished at his doctrine. 19 And when even was come, he went out of the city.

20 And in the morning, as they passed by, they saw the fig tree dried up from the roots. 21 And Peter calling to remembrance saith unto him, Master, behold, the fig tree which thou cursedst is withered away. 22 And Jesus answering saith unto them, **Have *pistis*/faith in God.** 23 For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say (*in aiteo*) unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. 24 Therefore I say unto you, **What things soever ye *aiteo*/desire**, when ye pray, believe that ye *lambano*/receive them, and ye shall have them. 25 And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses. 26 But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses.”

John 14:8 “Philip saith unto him, Lord, shew us the Father, and it sufficeth us. 9 Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou then, Shew us the Father? 10 Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works. 11 Believe me that I am in the Father, and the Father in me: or else **believe me for the very works' sake (to manifest the miracles yourself).** 12 Verily, verily, I (*Jesus*) say unto you, **He that *pisteuo*/believeth (by continual right faith-actions unto joy behaviors) on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.** 13 **And whatsoever ye shall *aiteo*/ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.** 14 **If ye shall *aiteo*/ask any thing in my name, I will do it.** 15 If ye love me, keep my commandments.”

John 15:7 “If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you *by the continual right faith-action lifestyle*, **ye shall *aiteo*/ask what ye will**, and it shall be done unto you. 8 Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples. 9 As the Father hath loved me, so have I loved you: continue ye in my love. 10 If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love. 11 These things have I spoken unto you, that my joy might remain in you, and that your joy might be full.”

John 16:13 “Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: **and he will shew you things to come.** 14 He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew it unto you. 15 **All things that the Father hath are mine: therefore said I, that he shall take of mine, and shall shew it unto you.** 16 A little while, and ye shall not see me: and again, a little while, and ye shall see me, because I go to the Father.”

John 16:22 “And ye now therefore have sorrow: but I will see you again, and your heart shall rejoice, and your joy no man taketh from you. 23 And in that day ye shall ask me nothing. Verily, verily, I say unto you, **Whatsoever ye shall *aiteo*/ask the Father in my name, he will give it you.** 24 Hitherto have ye *aiteo*/asked nothing in my name: ***aiteo*/ask, and ye shall receive**, that your joy may be full.”
